Jason Harris, Professor of Corporate Law, The University of Sydney

Jason Harris is Professor of Corporate Law at Sydney Law School where he teaches corporate law, contracts and insolvency. Jason is an active researcher in these areas and has published several books (including Keay's Insolvency with Michael Murray) and over 90 articles in scholarly and professional journals. Jason's research has been cited in the High Court, Federal Court, Federal Circuit Court and the Supreme Courts of NSW, Victoria, South Australia and Western Australia and in parliamentary committees and law reform reports. Jason is a member of the Insolvency and Restructuring Committee and the Corporations Committee of the Law Council of Australia and chairs the academic committee of the Banking and Financial Services Law Association. Jason is a fellow of the Governance Institute of Australia, a member of the legal committee of the Australian Institute of Company Directors and an academic member of ARITA and INSOL International.
