Emma Beechey came to the Bar in 2013. She practises primarily in the areas of insolvency, banking and finance, financial regulation, and commercial litigation. She regularly acts for local and foreign liquidators, major financial institutions including each of Australia's big four banks, corporations, investors and regulators. She appears in all Australian courts, most often in the Federal Court and the Supreme Court of New South Wales at both trial and appellate level.

Emma holds a Bachelor of Civil Law from the University of Oxford, a Bachelor of Law (Hons 1) from the University of Queensland and a Bachelor of Arts (Hons) from the University of Sydney. Before coming to the Bar, she was a solicitor at Henry Davis York and an Associate to the Hon Justice Susan Kiefel (now Chief Justice) in the High Court of Australia.

Her recent briefs have included acting for investors in relation to the collapse of Courtenay House in a successful appeal to the NSW Court of Appeal; for Cyrus Capital in its Virgin Australia bid; for Thai Airways on the Australian issues in its Thai business reorganisation; and for APRA in the Financial Services Royal Commission throughout 2018 and in ongoing related matters.
