Elizabeth Haydon is the director of Reporting and Stakeholder Engagement with the Foreign Investment Programs division of the Australia Taxation Office.

This role is involved the regulation of foreign investment into residential real estate under the Foreign Acquisitions and Takeovers Act (FATA) and keeping several registers of foreign ownership of land and water entitlements. The ATO operate under a coregulation partnership model with the Treasury and part of her role is managing this important relationship.

She has worked for the ATO for over 24 years, joining the graduate program way, way back in 1999.

For the first 15 years, she worked in income tax and GST compliance roles predominantly focused on high wealth taxpayers with foreign source income with the last 8 being focused on the regulation of foreign investment in Australia.
