Dr Henry Kha is Senior Lecturer in Law at Macquarie University. His main research interest is in all aspects of family law from both a legal historical and a contemporary perspective. Henry was previously lecturer at the University of Auckland and tutor at the University of Queensland. Henry was a legal associate in the Family Court of Australia, and he was admitted as a lawyer in New South Wales. He was the Australian National Rapporteur to the International Academy of Comparative Law on “Plurality and Diversity in Law: Family Forms and Family's Functions” in 2021. Henry’s research was cited in the 2019 Australian Law Reform Commission report, Family Law for the Future. He has appeared on television and radio to discuss family law issues, including on ABC and SBS.
