Dr Allan McCay is Co-Director of The Sydney Institute of Criminology and an Academic Fellow at the University of Sydney Law School. He is President of the Institute of Neurotechnology and Law, and was named by Australasian Lawyer as one of the most influential lawyers of 2021 and again in 2023. He is also a member of the Law Society of New South Wales Taskforce on AI & other tools and trends shaping the legal profession.

Amongst his many other publications, Dr McCay was commissioned by the Law Society of England and Wales to write the report *Neurotechnology, law and the legal profession* (2022), which was reported by media sources around the world in over 20 countries, including reports from the BBC and The Times. He regularly provides comments to the media including the Washington Post, The Australian, Sky News Arabia, The Indian Express and is a TEDx speaker as well as providing continuing professional development to law firms.
