A/Prof Porter was the founding academic and Head of the Forensic Science degree at the University of Western Sydney and has served as Vice President of the Australian Academy of Forensic Sciences. He is an experienced expert witness and his evidence has been heard or presented in various courts and jurisdictions including; the District and Supreme Courts of NSW, Coroners Court of NSW, NSW Court of Criminal Appeal (Sydney), High Court of Australia (Canberra) and the United Nations Human Rights Council (UNHRC) (Geneva). A/Prof Porter's forensic specialisations include forensic imaging, images as forensic evidence, crime scene investigation and shoe mark evidence.
